Applications are accepted annually in December and January. Resumés are matched to available positions starting February 1st, and work terms run from May to August. If your resume is received later than January, you will not be in the first round of applicants to be matched, however, you may still be matched with general labour or general administration positions.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

To be eligible for summer employment, you must be a student who is:

- at least 16 years of age;
- legally eligible to work in Canada;
- residing in Manitoba for the full duration of their work term;
- enrolled in full-time studies both before and after the work term (*students who will not be returning to school after the work term but require a co-op term to graduate are still eligible*).
