Nice Weather = Bikes

Nice weather means that bike use at the University of Manitoba will be higher through the late spring, summer, and early autumn months. You can expect to see our Bike Unit out in full force during this time.

Our bike unit can be seen patrolling campus, or responding to calls, with their high visibility uniforms and Security Services decal bikes. The high visibility nature of the unit is a very effective method of proactive crime prevention. The bike unit brings the guards and the community closer together; the guards are more approachable on bike versus patrolling by vehicle. Bike unit members can also perform

their duties in a manner that is not possible with a patrol vehicle such as riding through crowded areas, around buildings and obstacles. All of our Bike Unit members are Law Enforcement Bicycle Association (LEBA) Certified.



UNIVERSITY PARKADE BIKE STATION

The University Parkade Bike Station is a covered and enclosed parking facility for 100 bikes that is secured with a card lock system. Located on the ground level at the North-West corner of the Fort Garry Parkade, the Bike Station is conveniently located in the centre of campus adjacent to

University Centre. A public, self-serve bike repair centre, complete with tools and pumps is located just outside the Bike Station. To be granted card access to the Bike Station, students and staff can complete the registration form (found online) and arrange to have their U of M identification card programmed through Physical Plant.



The University Parkade Bike Station is located on the ground floor of the Fort Garry Parkade and is accessible from the West side.
