FRAUD PREVENTION MONTH

Fraud Prevention Month is an annual public awareness campaign held in March that works to prevent Canadians from becoming victims of fraud. The Chief Risk Officer at the University of Manitoba along with the Director of Security Services are both Certified Fraud Examiners (CFE). As members of the Association of Certified Fraud Examiners, they work with more than 75,000 members to reduce business fraud worldwide and inspire public confidence in the integrity and objectivity within the profession. CFEs have a unique set of skills they combine knowledge of complex financial transactions with an understanding of methods, law, and how to resolve fraud. Fraud examiners train to understand why and how fraud occurs.

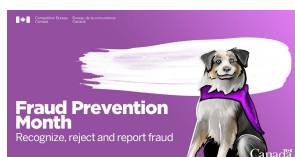
We have all heard stories of people becoming victims of fraud, whether it is an online scam, a phone scam, or identity theft. In many cases, we either know somebody that has become a victim, or have become a victim of fraud ourselves. This is the main reason for Fraud Prevention Month, to raise awareness so that we can lower the opportunity of fraud.



TIPS TO PROTECT YOURSELF FROM FRAUD:

- Do not be fooled by the promise of a valuable prize in return for a low-cost purchase.
- Be extra cautious about calls, E-mails, or mailings offering international bonds or lottery tickets, a portion of a foreign dignitary's bank account, free vacations, credit repair, or schemes with unlimited income potential.
- Do not be afraid to hang up the phone, delete the email, or close your Internet connection.
- Do not purchase a product or service without carefully checking out the product, service, and company.
- Do not be afraid to request further documentation from the caller so you can verify the validity of the Company.
- Do not disclose personal information about your finances, bank accounts, credit cards, social insurance, and driver's license numbers to any business that cannot prove it is legitimate.
- Shred unwanted personal information such as bank statements, credit card bills, receipts, pay - cheque, pre-approved credit applications and old tax returns.
- Check your credit report every year and report problems immediately.
- If a scam artist contacts you, or if you have been defrauded, report it! All reports are vital in helping law enforcement agencies in their investigations.
