1. The Advanced Learning Division provides institutional support grants to the University of Manitoba toward the academic and personal supports for students in the ACCESS programs. ACCESS programs enhance accessibility for priority groups consisting of northern Manitobans, Indigenous people, single parents, women, immigrants, refugees, visible minorities, and people with disabilities.
2. The reporting of degrees is based on a calendar year (February, May, and October graduands).
3. Program is exclusively for students of Indigenous ancestry.
4. In 2007, the Faculty of Nursing (now the College of Nursing), in partnership with the Access Program (under Extended Education), developed the Aboriginal Nursing Cohort Initiative (ANCI). In 2015, ANCI became solely under the operation of the College of Nursing. ANCI degrees reported under HCAP for the 2015 transition year.
5. UMAP includes students in the Education Access Program (EAP).
