- Program costs are calculated by multiplying the average cost per credit hour in a given faculty by the number of credit hours required to attain a degree.
The number of credit hours that are required for a degree are taken from the General Calendar.
- The cost for programs in the Faculties of Dentistry and Medicine are calculated by multiplying the cost per standard student by the number of years required to attain a degree.
- The Diploma program in Dental Hygiene is a two-year program but requires a qualifying year in the Faculties of Arts or Science. These costs reflect the two-year component.
- Due to the diversity of degrees available through the Clayton H. Riddell Faculty of Environment, Earth, and Resources, these program costs are an approximation based on 90 credit hours for a three-year degree and 120 credit hours for a four-year degree.
- In 2009-2010 expenditures in the Faculty of Human Ecology included an extra allocation of funds in Supplies & Expenses and Equipment & Alterations to cover the losses incurred from the fire in the Duff Roblin Building in March 2009.
