- Program costs are calculated by multiplying the average cost per credit hour in a given faculty by the number of credit hours required to attain a degree.  
The number of credit hours that are required for a degree are taken from the General Calendar. Financial data are taken from the Annual Financial Report March 31.
- Due to the diversity of degrees available through the Clayton H. Riddell Faculty of Environment, Earth, and Resources, these program costs are an approximation based on 90 credit hours for a three-year degree and 120 credit hours for a four-year degree.
- In 2016, the Faculty of Health Sciences changed its name to the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences and the College of Medicine changed its name to the Max Rady College of Medicine.
- The cost for programs in the College of Dentistry and the Max Rady College of Medicine are calculated by multiplying the cost per standard student by the number of years required to attain a degree.
- The Diploma program in the School of Dental Hygiene is a two-year program; these costs reflect the two-year component.
