- Where program fees are used instead of per credit hour fees, the cost of tuition for the year is shown, unless otherwise stated. All figures exclude endowment fund contributions, student organization fees, fieldwork fees, material or equipment related fees.
- Fees for Engineering represent those for years 2-5. Fees for Business represent those for years 2-4. Fees for Education represent all years of undergraduate education programs except for years 1-3 of NITEP, which is \$148 per credit hour. Tuition for Dentistry, Medicine and Law is for the 2009-2010 entering cohort.
- Both Law and Medicine include a \$4,356 program differential fee. Dentistry and Dental Hygiene fees include Clinical Operations Fees.
- The fee per course in the Faculty of Law is \$983. The maximum tuition fee per session in the Faculty of Medicine is \$7192.
- Students in the Diploma in Agriculture program pay half the cost per credit unit. Fee shown is half the cost per credit unit for courses in the Agriculture Degree program. Tuition in the Faculty of Law is based on 30 credit hour course load.
- Fees are assessed on a per course or program fee basis. The fee per credit hour was calculated by dividing the stated fees for the program by 30 credit hours (the number of credit hours in an average year). Fee shown for Business is a program fee.
- Fees are assessed on a per course or program fee basis. The fee per credit hour was calculated by dividing the stated fees for the program by 30 credit hours (the number of credit hours in an average year). Many programs have different fees for new students and continuing students. In all cases, except Management, tuition shown is that of the 2009-2010 entering cohort. Tuition for Management reflects the fee paid by the continuing group as the entrance cohort pays the same fees as Arts during the first year of their program.
- Tuition fees were restructured in 2009-2010, resulting in lower fees than reported in previous years. Pharmacy students must also pay a compulsory \$1500 clinical fieldwork fee.
- Fees shown are for degree and/or diploma programs in Dental Hygiene.
