- Where program fees are used instead of per credit hour fees, the cost of tuition for the year is shown, unless otherwise stated. All figures exclude endowment fund contributions, student organization fees, material or equipment related fees.
- Fees for Engineering represent those for years 2-5. Fees for Business represent those for years 2-4. Fees for Education represent all years of undergraduate education programs except for years 1-3 of the Bachelor of Education (Elementary) program, which is \$134 per credit hour. Tuition for Dentistry, Medicine and Law is for the 2004-2005 entering cohort.
- Fees are assessed on a per course basis. The fee per three credit hour course in most faculties is \$453 or \$151 per credit hour. Both Law and Medicine include a \$4,000 program differential fee.
- The fee per course in the Faculty of Law is \$875. The maximum tuition fee per session in the Faculty of Medicine is \$6394
- Tuition in the Faculty of Law is based on 30 credit hour course load.
- Fees are assessed on a per course or program fee basis. In programs that utilize course fees, the fee per three credit hour course in most faculties is \$414 or \$138 per credit hour. The exceptions are Education and Engineering, which have higher per course fees.
- Fees are assessed on a per course or program fee basis. The fee per credit hour was calculated by dividing the stated fees for the program by 30 credit hours (the number of credit hours in an average year). Many programs have different fees for new students and continuing students. In all cases, except Management, tuition shown is that of the 2004-05 entering cohort. Tuition for Management reflects the fee paid by the continuing group as the entrance cohort pays the same fees as Arts during the first year of their program.
- The fees shown do not incorporate the 10% rebate received by students from the Manitoba Government. First year Pharmacy students must also pay a compulsory \$1500 tuition surcharge. Tuition for the Faculty of Law is \$6521 for first and second year students, continuing students pay \$4521.

A Maintaining Registration Fee of \$1064 is charged for keeping program active but not completing any work. All fees for coursework, projects or thesis are credit hour based and vary by student.

1. Graduate fees represent those for standard Art and Science programs. Where a range is given fees vary by program.
2. Continuing fees have been calculated to reflect what a student would pay for an additional year of study in order to make fees comparable across institutions.
3. One calendar year is equal to three semesters.
4. The Master's fee represented is the fee that non-Quebec Canadian students pay. All Canadians, regardless of province, pay the same fee for a Ph.D. program.
5. The fees shown do not incorporate the 10% rebate received by students from the Manitoba government.
