**DISPOSAL OF HAZARDOUS AND RADIOACTIVE WASTE
Fort Garry Campus**

On the **Fort Garry Campus** Environmental Health & Safety will accept and collect **Radioactive waste** on the high-lighted day every month. Please use the Radioactive Waste Removal Form which can be found in the Manual or on our web site:

You can also email the request to: radsafe@umanitoba.ca with the following information:

- Type of waste (liquid, solid etc.)
- Number of containers, Container size
- Permit number and permit holder
- Location of the waste, Contact person and phone #

Radioactive waste must be packaged, labelled and disposed to EHS within 6 months as outlined in the Radiation Safety Manual. **No radioactive liquid waste disposal by drain is permitted.** Stock vials must be packaged separately in a small box with a corresponding radioisotope inventory form (gold sheet). Please attach the Radioactive Waste tags to the **sides** of boxes and containers. **Please attach the radioactive waste tags to bottles of liquid with string or twine.** The *full trade or chemical names of components must be written on the waste tag in order for EHS staff to be able to look up the related MSDS and the activity recorded in MBq.*

Hazardous waste will not be collected on specific dates. Make your requests for pick-up by faxing (204) 474-7629 the completed Hazardous Waste Removal Form to the EHS. If you have any questions or need more forms or labels contact the EHS at (204) 474-6633.

In accordance with the Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System (WHMIS), all containers of chemicals including hazardous waste must be labelled. Containers without an appropriate label indicating the contents and risk will no longer be accepted for disposal by EHS.

If a container does not have a correct manufacturer's label, or if the waste is a cocktail of different materials, a University of Manitoba Hazardous Waste LABEL must be used for NON-RADIOACTIVE Hazardous Waste.

Radioactive Waste TAG must be used for all **RADIOACTIVE Waste.**

Waste tags or labels MUST list the chemical names of components in order for EHS staff to be able to look up the related MSDS.
