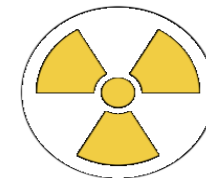

NEW for Radioactive waste Environmental Health & Safety will accept Radioactive waste from the Bannatyne Campus and RIOH in room 071 Brodie (next to the steam tunnel entrance) on the **second Thursday of the month between 9:00 and 10:00 am** (Alternate arrangements may be possible).

Package and label waste as outlined in the Radiation Safety Manual (RSP-3, section 12) and the Quick Step Guide for radioactive waste found in the records binder.

- **No radioactive liquid waste disposal by drain is permitted** and do not put any radioactive stock vials in solid waste.

Radioactive Waste Tag must be used for all RADIOACTIVE Waste. Prior to collecting waste, fill out the top portion of the waste tag and if a chemical or biological hazard is present, **list the full chemical names** of components or the **biological disinfectant** used.

Containers without an appropriate label indicating the contents and hazards will not be accepted for disposal by EHS.

- Attach the Radioactive Waste tags to the sides of boxes and containers.
- Attach the waste tags to bottles of liquid with string or twist ties.
- **Record the activity of the waste inside the container in MBq** and indicate the weight or volume of the waste.

Transfer waste containers to EHS within 6 months of the date started.

ALL WASTES SHOULD BE TRANSPORTED in a secondary container, which is spill proof, and of suitable capacity. Transport wastes with an appropriate cart. Use the service elevator instead of passenger elevators when available.
