WHO?

LACFIEA is free of charge for qualified applicants in agricultural fields such as farming, agricultural engineering, animal sciences, plant sciences, seed sciences, soil sciences, entomology, agronomy, agribusiness, agricultural economics, and many others. Participants must live in Manitoba and have CLB levels of 7 or higher.

WHY?

The focus of this program is on functional language needed for success on the job, at college or university programs, the IEAP Program or in academic level ESL programs such as AEPUCE. This program also develops the participant's cross-cultural awareness, especially as it applies to the workplace.
