Seasonal Employment Opportunities

1) Yard Assistant

About 6 week term position – starting late April 2012 until June 15th – duties would be driving a fertilizer truck, tendering fertilizer to fields for the custom application. Class 3 license is required.

2) Truck Driver

About a 6 month term position – starting late April 2011 until June 15th Duties include driving fertilizer trucks, water trucks, plus various yard duties. Class 3 license is required.

3) Summer Field Scout / Assistant

Term(s): late April to Sept / 2012. This person's duties will mainly involve field scouting for weeds, diseases, and insects, and filling out reports / contacting growers. Other duties may include, but are not limited to: Soil Testing (GPS), fertilizer blending, shipping and receiving, and other general agro-related duties as assigned.

Applications may be eligible for the Student Development Program – Qualifications – year 1 of a 2 year diploma program or year 2 of a degree program – Students are hired for summer employment and follow a training plan in preparation for department manager training. Upon graduation, they return to complete the program as a full time trainee. A tuition lump sum could be paid to students 2 years after graduation and continuous CRS employment
