#### Start of Term:

For ED **AMP 1 students**: All students are required to take the **Arch Tech Prep** course, EVAR 3012 - Architectural Technology Preparation: Structural Concepts; it starts on Monday morning, August 31, 2020 and will run for that (full) week. This year, the course will be delivered remotely due to the ongoing generalized health crisis: you will receive an invitation link via e-mail.

# STUDIO PRESENTATIONS AND WELCOME

<u>All Masters Students:</u> There will be a Graduate Student Orientation on Tuesday September 8 at 9:00 am, delivered remotely via Webex or similar; you will receive in invitation link via e-mail. <u>All Students:</u> There will be a Studio Presentation on Tuesday September 8 at 10:00 am, delivered remotely via Webex or similar; you will receive an invitation link via e-mail. Following a welcome address from the Head of Architecture, each instructor conducting a studio will give a 5-10 minute presentation on their offering to the entire student body. Following the presentations, M1, M2, ED AMP2 and ED4 students will select and rank three studios, at their respective level, which they wish to join. An online form will be sent to your U of M email early afternoon and it must be submitted by 9am September 9th. <u>ED-AMP1 and ED3 students will be assigned their studios</u>.

The Department Head will establish the final studio groups. In establishing the studio groups, every attempt will be made to satisfy student interests, while achieving equitable groups in term of size and diversity. It is possible that students will not get one of their top choices. The Department Head's decision is final.

Design Thesis students may pre-arrange with an advisor. Each advisor can pre-sign up to three Design Thesis students only. Design Thesis students who do not pre-arrange an advisor are required to attend the Studio Presentations and participate in the selection process. 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<u>All Master Students:</u> a Topics course offering presentation will take place at 2:00 pm on September 8 via Webex or similar, which all Master students must attend. The Topics selection process is handled in a similar manner as the studios.

Studio assignments will be announced via e-mail by noon on Thursday September 10<sup>th</sup>. Studio introductions begin that afternoon at 2 pm. In the interim you will receive an email invitation; please be especially attentive to your inbox that day.

#### COVID-19 and Studio:

The Faculty of Architecture has been approved in principle for partial in-person Studio teaching following University directives and provincial social distancing, health, and sanitation, protocols. **Studios will typically run on Mondays and Thursdays. Studio courses will combine in-person and online instruction.** Currently, as it stands now, the Department is able to assign each student a dedicated work station (with a designated desk, chair and locker). However, due to requirements for physical distancing, studio groups will be split into two sub-groups for in-person studio meetings in order to reduce the occupancy of our building to 50% at any given time. Building and facilities access will be allowed, but reduced and restricted. Further information to follow.

### **COVID-19 and Courses:**

All other courses (with the exception of studio) will be taught online.

### **IMPORTANT NOTICE:**

Faculty and Department are in the process of preparing remote learning guidelines, for studio and lecture courses. The new protocols and guidelines will be available on the Department website by August 17. Please be aware, however, that the circumstances around COVID-19 are fluid. Should a major outbreak occur, or and/or health protocols changes, it is possible in-person studio instruction will also revert to online instruction.

### **REGISTRATION:**

<u>Masters students</u>: Once your studio choice has been finalized, you will have to register in AURORA as soon as possible. All registration must be finalized by **Sept. 11th, 2020** 

Environmental Design - Architecture Option Years ED3, ED4 and ED-AMP1 & ED-AMP2 Students: Once studio sections have been finalized, you will be notified through email <u>At that time you can register in Aurora for the appropriate studio</u> section for both Fall and Winter term Studios; this should be done by <u>September 10th, 2020</u>.
