### Notes:

1. Students who wish to take a lighter course load in their first year are recommended to take their English Literature and Mathematics Requirement courses in year two. These requirements should be completed within the first 60 credit hours of the program.
2. The School of Art offers FA 1020 – Mathematics in Art which can be taken to fulfil this requirement. See the General Academic Regulations Section of the Undergraduate Calendar for a full list of courses that meet this requirement.
3. English Literature Requirement – Any course taken through the English Department (Subject code ENGL). Most students will complete a 1000 level English course to fulfil this requirement.
4. Social Science or Science - A list of the currently offered courses that will fulfil this requirement can be obtained through Aurora Student > Class Schedule > Advanced Search by selecting the appropriate “Attribute” from the list.
5. **Studio Electives** can be fulfilled by any Studio course taught by the School of Art, listed under the code STDO. For the purposes of this component, STDO 1510 Art Now is not considered as Studio Elective.
6. **Academic electives:** courses offered outside of the School of Art.
7. Students wishing to transfer from the three year General program to the four year Honours program can request to transfer after completion of 70 credit hours of course work in Bachelor of Fine Arts – 3 years Art History program. Have minimum Degree GPA no lower than 2.50.
8. **Art History Electives** can be fulfilled by any Art History course taught by School of Art, listed under the code FAAH. In addition to the courses taught by the School of Art, the following courses from other faculties fulfil the Art History elective requirements. (Not all courses taught every year). CLAS 2670 Greek Art and Archaeology (3 cr. Hrs.), CLAS 2680 Roman Art and Archaeology (3 cr. Hrs.), RLGN 2570 Indian Religious Art and Architecture (3 cr. Hrs.), TXSC 2420 History of Textiles (3 cr. Hrs.).
9. Note that all 2000 level studios require a completion of 21 cr. Hrs. of 1000 level studios. It is rare to be able to take 2000 level studios in Art History program.
10. Honours students wishing to take more than 18 credit hours of Art History may use their academic electives to do so.
