FINDING A CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGIST

Publically Funded Clinical Psychologists:

• Department of Clinical Health Psychology Central Referral Line

A referral from your primary care clinician is preferred, and self-referrals are usually not accepted. Most services involve a waiting period and not all psychological services are available. Call the intake line for more information.
