The University of Manitoba (the “University”) grants the undersigned user access to the Bike Station subject to the following terms and conditions:

## Terms & Conditions:

To park your bike at the University of Manitoba Parkade Bike Station (the “Bike Station”) you must first read and agree to the following terms and conditions. When the University accepts your application to become a Bike Station user, your application and the following terms and conditions will become a binding contract.

1. Use of the Bike Station is at user’s own risk, any damage to or loss of equipment or personal property is user’s sole responsibility. The University of Manitoba is not responsible for any injuries or any lost, stolen or damaged bicycles or other personal property arising from use of the Bike Station.
2. Access to the bike station does not guarantee that rack space will always be available.
3. For the purpose of security, only those with authorized access are permitted into the bike station. Authorized users must not permit others entry to the Bike Station.
4. Lost or stolen access cards must be reported immediately to Security Services (see page 2 for contact information).

5. **Access to the bike station will expire on April 30th of each year.** To gain access after the expiry date a new application must be submitted.
6. All bicycles in the station require a lock. It is generally accepted that high quality U-locks offer better protection than cable-style locks.
7. Abandoned bicycles will be taken to the University Bike Shop and held for 90 days, after which they will be donated.
8. Suspicious activity in and around the bike station should be reported to Security Services (see below for contact information).
9. Failure to comply with these terms and conditions, or other directions of the University of Manitoba regarding the use of the bike station, may result in access rights being terminated.
10. Access to the bike station may be terminated by the University of Manitoba at any time.
11. The Bike Station shall be used solely for the purposes of storing bicycles, helmet, jacket or outer clothing, a pack and other cyclist equipment. Users will not store food, perishable items, hazardous or combustible materials, including oils and aerosol cans in the Bike Station at any time.
12. I agree to release and indemnify the University and its employees, agents and volunteers from any liability for any damage or injury to myself or my property resulting from and including any indirect, special, incidental or consequential damages or injuries arising out of, or in connection with my use of the Bike Station. I agree to release the University and its employees, agents and volunteers from any liability for the theft, loss or removal of any property stored by me in the Bike Station.
