



## 2012 - SUMMER PARKING

For Motorcycle Parking and Summer Vehicle Permit Holders Only

### Fort Garry Motorcycle Parking (per Calendar Month)

- Fort Garry MOTORCYCLE parking permits must be displayed on all motorcycles, motor-scooters and mopeds parked at the Fort Garry Campus at designated motorcycle areas between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- Motorcycles, motor-scooters and mopeds are considered motor vehicles by The University of Manitoba and require permits. Permits are available on a monthly basis at a charge of \$25.00 (plus GST). Motorcycles, motor-scooters and mopeds must park in designated motorcycle areas.
- Permits are not required during the evening hours or weekends. However, parking is not permitted at anytime in 24-hour reserved, restricted areas or parkade. Please note that accessible spaces, fire lanes, no parking zones, loading zones, landscaped areas, parkade, etc., are prohibited parking zones and may not be used at any time. Fort Garry Motorcycle permits are not valid at Bannatyne Campus.

### Fort Garry Summer Vehicle Parking Permit Holders (May 1 to August 31)

- All vehicles parking in reserved areas between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday, must have a valid parking permit clearly displayed in the correct location:
  - a) temporary permit – hanging from the rear view mirror.
  - b) plastic hang tag – hanging from the rear view mirror.
- Permits must be completely visible from the exterior of the vehicle at all times. Permits are not required during the evening hours or weekends. However, parking is not permitted at anytime in 24-hour reserved, restricted areas or Parkade. Please note that accessible spaces, fire lanes, no parking zones, loading zones, landscaped areas, parkade, etc., are prohibited parking zones and may not be used at any time. Summer permits are not permitted at the Bannatyne Campus.
- Summer permit holders are authorized to park, on a scramble basis, in any **regular student lot** on campus. Vehicles must be parked within the stall structure of the lot (i.e., no parking beyond or between rows). The cost of a 2012 summer permit is \$200.00 (plus GST). Please note that summer permits are **non-refundable**.
