Subject: Safety and Conduct Rules



The purpose of this chapter of the Safety and Health Manual is to highlight the importance of safety and conduct rules in Physical Plant. These are to be read in conjunction with the Safe Work and Safe Job chapters and provide an additional layer of non-task specific guidance.

It is the responsibility of every employee to perform work in a safe manner. To carry out that responsibility, it is essential to know and practice Physical Plant safety and conduct rules as we interact with others and respond to situations that may develop. We are expected to follow established safety and conduct rules, creating and maintaining a safe, productive and respectful learning and working environment. This joint effort between supervisors and workers and must include continual monitoring and prompt correction of inappropriate actions.

As per the University Policy and Collective Agreements, enforcement is essential for the safety of all employees.

Physical Plant safety and conduct rules serve to manage risks that may arise and reduce our accidents / injury rates and creating a positive working atmosphere.
