David Stewart is a Professor of Political Science at the University of Calgary and the author of many works on provincial politics and party leadership including *Conventional Choices: Maritime Leadership Politics* and *Quasi-Democracy? Parties and Leadership Selection in Alberta.*

The **Duff Roblin Professor of Government** was established in the department of Political Studies in 1998 with a generous endowment from the Honourable Duff Roblin, PC, CC, OM, the 14th premier of Manitoba. His intention was to enhance the study of Canadian government and public affairs, and to aid the educational development of younger scholars through the Duff Roblin Graduate Fellowship program, which is overseen by the Duff Roblin professor.

The **Manitoba Institute for Policy Research** is based in the department of Political Studies in the Faculty of Arts at the University of Manitoba. The Institute serves as a hub for academic analysis, public policy discourse, and outreach.
