TITLE: Peer Review Board Member (Volunteer)

POSITION LENGTH: Approximately 1 year, with the possibility of renewal

(September 2014 – August 2015)

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Volunteer Peer Review Board members will be responsible for the initial selection and editing of papers submitted to the journal. They will perform necessary logistical tasks to ensure the publication of the journal once a year. They will also be responsible for planning and executing a summer colloquium where published papers are presented.

Board Members will coordinate a marketing plan for the journal. They will communicate submission information to the affiliated faculties and post-secondary institutions. They will work under the supervision of the Student Editor.

ELIGIBILITY:

Applicants must be (or plan to be) registered as students at the University of Manitoba for both terms of the upcoming academic year.
