

Advanced Registration Form for St John's College Members (2007/08)

St John's College (SJC) members may use this form to request advanced registration in sections of University of Manitoba courses taught at SJC in Fall Term 2007 and Winter Term 2008, and in corresponding lab sections for those courses (even if the lab is held in another building).

Requests for advanced registration must be submitted by fax (204) 474-7610 or in person no later than **4:30 pm July 12/07**. Advanced registration submissions will be processed by the SJC Registrar between **8:30 am July 11** and **noon July 13/07**.

Students who miss the advanced registration period may register in SJC courses using Aurora Student on or after their initial Registration Time, provided there is space in the course and they meet the course prerequisites. You may determine your initial Registration Time at Aurora Student.

Students must meet all University of Manitoba requirements and course prerequisites. Students who have been placed on hold status are not eligible for advanced registration.

SJC membership is open to all students of the University of Manitoba. Current students can declare St John's as their college of membership using Aurora Student on or after July 5, 2007. A membership fee will be added to the tuition fees of SJC members.
