The **Martin Kavanagh-Gaultier La Vérendrye Fellowship** was established for research relating to the legacy of La Vérendrye. This includes research specifically relating to La Vérendrye but also on such topics as the fur trade in Canada, the culture and history of New France, the development of western Canada within Confederation, the links between Quebec and western Canada, and the political economy of western Canada in the modern era.

CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

The **Martin Kavanagh-Gaultier La Vérendrye Fellowship** is awarded to students on the basis of the following criteria:

- membership at St. Paul's College at time of application*
- enrolment in the Faculty of Graduate Studies
- demonstrating ability to use research materials in the French language
- submitting a letter of intent with this application
- your curriculum vitae
- your relevant transcript
- your research proposal
- two reference letters must accompany this application before the deadline

Students will be notified in June. The Award will be given out in September at the Opening Ceremonies.

*All University of Manitoba students are welcome to apply and to become members of the College by requesting their preference for membership via the Aurora system. Membership fee is \$19 per term.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

The application must be received in the Dean's Office prior to or on **May 1** to receive consideration. If the deadline falls on a weekend or holiday, it will be extended until 4:30 p.m. the next business day.
