

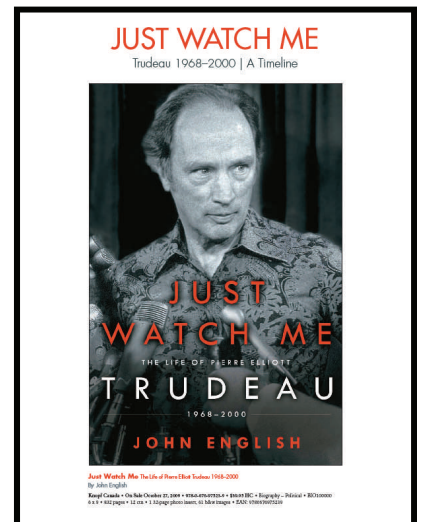

Oh Fuddle Duddle: The Perils of Penning Pierre Trudeau's Biography

a public lecture by

John English

Professor of history at the University of Waterloo and general editor of *The Dictionary of Canadian Biography*, John English has researched Canadian history and the lives of some of its key actors. He is the author of award-winning biographies (including the Dafoe Prize) of four Canadian prime ministers: Arthur Meighen, Robert Borden, Lester Pearson and Pierre Elliott Trudeau (with vol. 2 scheduled for release on October 27th, 2009). An iconic figure, Pierre Elliott Trudeau inspired strong feelings amongst his most enthusiastic supporters and his greatest political enemies. Only his biographer, historian John English, has had access to and has read the entire collection of **Pierre Trudeau's** personal papers. He has learned and documented things that will only strengthen Canadians' opinions about this enigmatic prime minister, whether they love him or hate him. In this year's **W. L. Morton Memorial Lecture**, Professor English will share some remarkable and fascinating stories and will offer a taste of the revelations he expands upon in the second volume of his biography of Pierre Elliott Trudeau.
