

THESIS DEFENCE PREPARATION

In order to begin the advertising process for the public defense of a thesis certain arrangements must be made. Disability Studies requires the following at least one month prior to the Thesis Defense:

- Thesis title
- Abstract of thesis
- List of thesis committee

After receiving these items Disability Studies will then circulate notices to all faculties, staff and the university at large.
