## **Membership Application**

CEOS membership reflects interest in conducting natural or social science research in northern environments and ecosystems and doing so using a 'system science' or other interdisciplinary or transdisciplinary approach. Research interests include the cryosphere and drivers of cryospheric change, rivers and landscape studies across Canada's Arctic watershed using a variety of tools. Research addresses questions related to northern coastal oceans, in-land waters and icescapes including glaciers, understanding linkages between warming, sea-ice loss, ecosystem change and impacts for people, and Indigenous governance. Several CEOS research projects are community-driven and/or conducted in partnership with northern communities and regional organizations. While most CEOS research is conducted in the northern high latitudes, there has been, and is on-going research in Antarctica, and well as in temperate and tropical environments. CEOS is also known as an international leader in polynya research and champion of research in Canada's Inland Seas (Hudson Bay, James Bay, Hudson Strait and Foxe Basin).

Any faculty member or research associate with affiliation to the University of Manitoba is welcome to join CEOS where there is good fit in research expertise, and there is a desire to positively contribute toward the development of proposals and the subsequent research in support of CEOS activities. Students supervised by CEOS members are encouraged to join CEOS. New members are sometimes sought out based on their research profile. Interested individuals are also invited to approach a CEOS member for more information or nomination. Membership can be full, affiliate (less than 60% of activities related to CEOS), or student. Each membership application will be discussed by the CEOS council in the context of CEOS strategic planning and a response provided in writing to the applicant.

Full members include those who run funds through CEOS financial administrators. Affiliate membership is confirmed every 3 years. A faculty member may cease to be a member in the event their research interests diverge from those of other CEOS members. The Scientific Director will initiate a discussion with the faculty member to establish whether there is the 'will' to maintain engagement with the Centre.

For all members, there are expectations that a member acknowledges the support received by CEOS in regard to resources, expertise, and ideas. We expect that members will acknowledge CEOS through the use of the CEOS unit identifier (CEOS logo) in scientific presentations, and through the acknowledgments and/or affiliations in publications or other research products.
