The Faculty of Education Alumni Association Excellence in Teaching Awards for Early, Middle and Senior Years Teachers were created to recognize the important work of teachers in Manitoba.

One award will be given to an Early Years (K-4) Teacher, a Middle Years (5-8) Teacher, and a Senior Years (S1-S4) Teacher. [Teachers do not necessarily need to be classroom teachers. Other areas such as resource, counseling, art, music and drama are also applicable.]

The criteria for each award is:

- Nominee must be a graduate of the University of Manitoba, Faculty of Education.
- Nominee must currently be teaching in Manitoba.
- Nominee must be nominated by at least five people (at least two of whom must be educators).
- Nominee continues to teach in Manitoba.

Award recipients will have demonstrated one or more of the following characteristics:

- Teaching excellence.
- Creativity and initiative.
- Commitment to education.
- Ongoing professional growth.
- Positive contribution to teaching.
- Introduction/implementation of new/pilot programs.

- Community members
- Students
