

Indigenous Education and Special Education/Diversity Requirements Courses

As part of your degree, you are required, throughout the course of your program, to present three (3) credit hours of coursework in Indigenous Education and three (3) credit hours of Special Education/Diversity.

Early Years students meet the Special Education/Diversity requirement by taking the course **EDUB 3018**. You do not need to register in an additional Special Education/Diversity course.

If you are intending to take your practicum(s) in Year 1, you **must** complete these course(s) in Year 1.

Review the list of courses and register in **one** Indigenous Education course

The following courses meet the Indigenous Education requirement. Choose **one**:

- EDUA 3404 (3) Indigenous Education (or the former EDUA 3400)
- EDUB 3406 (3) Indigenous Perspectives and the Curriculum (or the former EDUB 3042)

NOTE: As the course EDUB 3018 is offered in the Winter term, Year 1 Early Years students planning to take EDUB 3310 (Practicum 1) in the Fall term **must take the Indigenous Education Requirement in the Fall.**
