JAMES H. CAMERON SCHOLARSHIP

From the testamentary gift of James Hugh Cameron a scholarship fund has been established at The University of Manitoba. Beginning with the spring series of examinations in 1982, one or more scholarships, not necessarily of equal value but with none less in value than \$250, will be available to a total of \$900 to students who:

- (1) have completed at a "high level of excellence" the third year of the Bachelor of Education degree program, either in the elementary or secondary stream;
- (2) have displayed high potential for teaching as determined by reports in Seminar and School Experience I and II;
- (3) proceed in the next ensuing academic year to the fourth year of the Bachelor of Education program.

The state of the fund supporting this scholarship will be reviewed regularly and, if earnings permit, the amount available for award may be increased.

If for any reason a student selected to receive this scholarship does not register as required, the scholarship will then be awarded by reversion to the next qualified candidate.

The selection committee will be named by, and will include, the Dean of the Faculty of Education. Within the amount of money available, the committee will determine each year whether one or more scholarships will be offered.
