MARGUERITE MURRAY SCHOLARSHIPS

From the testamentary gift of Mrs. Marguerite Fryer a scholarship fund has been established at The University of Manitoba. Mrs. Fryer's Will directs that the scholarship be in her maiden name, Marguerite Murray.

From this fund, effective for first tenability in the 1987-88 academic year, an annual scholarship valued at half of the available annual income from the fund, will be offered to a student who:

- (1) is entering the Faculty of Education After-Degree Program (Middle Years) with high standing:
- (2) registers for, and remains in, the Curriculum and Instruction courses, plus the practicum, in the year in which the scholarship is tenable.

The scholarship will be renewed in the amount of half of the available annual income from the fund, provided that the recipient:

- (1) has entered the second year of the After-Degree Program (Middle Years), having achieved a minimum grade point average of 3.0;
- (2) registers for, and remains in, the Curriculum and Instruction courses, plus the practicum, in the year in which the renewal is tenable.

The state of the fund supporting these scholarships will be reviewed annually and, if the value of the fund permits, the amount of the scholarships (initial and renewal) will be increased.

The selection committee will be named by the Dean of the Faculty of Education and will include the associate dean (elementary program) and a representative of the Financial Aid and Awards Office.
