- (3) has achieved a minimum grade point average of 3.0, or has met admission requirements for the Bachelor of Education degree program (e.g., After-Degree Bachelor of Education program) in the Faculty of Education.

Preference will be given to those students who are planning to teach Human Ecology or Home Economics at the Senior Years level and have community service/volunteer experience during their program focusing on Home Economics (e.g., extra-curricular experiences in a practicum school, community programs, etc.).

The Dean of the Faculty of Education (or designate) will name and chair the selection committee.

The Board of Governors of the University of Manitoba has the right to modify the terms of this award if, because of changed conditions, it becomes necessary to do so. Such modification shall conform as closely as possible to the expressed intention of the donor in establishing the award.
