Doris and Gar Hindle Bursary

An endowment of fund of \$25,000 has been established at the University of Manitoba in honour of Gar and Doris Hindle. Doris and Gar served Canada overseas during World War II and later served the community of St. Vital as role models and educators. Doris was an elementary school teacher in the St. Vital School District for over 15 years and Gar worked at the Canadian National Railway as a signal maintainer for over 43 years and was a talented athlete and carver. The award reflects the value they both placed on education. One bursary, valued at the available annual interest on the fund, will be offered to an undergraduate or graduate student who:

- (1) is enrolled part-time or full-time, in any year of study, in a Bachelor of Education, Master of Education, or Doctorate of Education degree program;
- as an undergraduate student, has achieved a minimum sessional grade point average of 2.5 in the previous year of study, or as a graduate student has achieved a minimum degree grade point average of 3.0 (or equivalent) based on the last 60 credit hours of study;
- (3) has demonstrated financial need on the standard University of Manitoba bursary application form.

The selection committee will be named by the Director of Financial Aid and Awards.
