## VIRGINIA LUCAS MEMORIAL BURSARY IN EDUCATION

A bursary fund has been established at The University of Manitoba by the family and friends of Virginia Lucas (B.Sc.H.Ec./47, Teacher's College). The purpose of the fund is to provide bursary assistance to students pursuing studies in the two-year After-Degree Program in the Faculty of Education. The Manitoba Scholarship and Bursary Initiative has made a contribution to this fund. The first bursary is to be offered in 2005.

The available annual interest generated by the fund is to be offered each year as a bursary to a student who:

- (1) enrolls full-time in the two-year After-Degree Program (Middle or Senior Years) in the Faculty of Education at the University of Manitoba;
- (2) has achieved a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 (or equivalent) in his/her previous degree;
- (3) has demonstrated financial need on the standard University of Manitoba bursary application form.

The selection committee shall be named by the Dean of the Faculty of Education.
