MANITOBA ASSOCIATION OF SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENTS BURSARY

The Manitoba Association of School Superintendents, with assistance from The Winnipeg Foundation, offers to provide an annual bursary, initially valued at \$400, in the Faculty of Education to an Aboriginal student. In addition to the bursary offered at the University of Manitoba, bursaries will be offered at Brandon University, Collège Universitaire de Saint-Boniface, and the University of Winnipeg. The first bursary will be offered in the 2004-2005 academic session.

The bursary will be offered to a student who:

- (1) is Aboriginal (Status, non-Status, Métis, Inuit);
- (2) is enrolled as a full-time student in any year of study in the Faculty of Education;
- (3) has achieved a minimum grade point average of 2.5 (first year students must have achieved a 2.5 grade point average in their last year of full-time study (minimum 18 credit hours));
- (4) has demonstrated financial need on the standard University of Manitoba bursary application form.

The Winnipeg Foundation will confirm the value of future awards on an annual basis.

The selection committee shall be named by the Dean of the Faculty of Education (or designate).
