## ISABEL WETTLAUFER SCHOLARSHIP

As a tribute to Isabel Wettlaufer, B.Sc., H.Ec., B.Ed., on the occasion of her retirement, her colleagues and friends offer to establish an annual scholarship at The University of Manitoba.

This scholarship will have an annual value of \$100 and will first be awarded following the spring series of examinations in 1983.

The award shall be made to a student in the Faculty of Education of The University of Manitoba who:

- (1) has completed with distinction the certification year in the Human Ecology area;
- (2) has in the judgment of the selection committee given clear evidence of teaching competence;
- (3) has shown special interest in the aptitude for home economics instruction.

Among factors to be considered by the selection committee are: scholarship, leadership, creativity, and innovation.

The selection committee will be named by the Dean of the Faculty of Education and will include those staff members who teach courses in Human Ecology for Education credit.

The state of the fund supporting this scholarship will be reviewed regularly and if earnings permit, the amount available for the award may be increased.

The University of Manitoba has the right to modify the terms of this award if, because of changed conditions, it becomes necessary to do so. Such modification shall conform as closely as possible to the expressed intention of the donors in establishing the award, i.e., to reward a student exhibiting excellence in the teaching of home economics.
