

Indigenous Education and Inclusive Education/Diversity Requirements Courses

As part of your degree, you are required, throughout the course of your program, to present three (3) credit hours of coursework in Indigenous Education and three (3) credit hours of Inclusive Education/Diversity.

Review the list of courses and register in **one** Indigenous Education course and **one** Inclusive Education/Diversity course that fit your schedule. These courses are to be selected from the lists below and are completed one per term.

If you are intending to take your practicum(s) in Year 1, you **must** complete these course(s) in Year 1.

The following courses meet the Indigenous Education requirement.

- EDUA 3404 (3) Indigenous Education (or the former EDUA 3400)
- EDUB 3406 (3) Indigenous Perspectives and the Curriculum (or the former EDUB 3042)

The following courses meet the Inclusive Education/Diversity requirement.

- EDUA 3420 (3) Cross Cultural Education
- EDUA 3422 (3) An Introduction to Childhood Trauma and Its Impact in the Classroom (or the former EDUA 3502 with same title)
- EDUB 3506 (3) Principles and Procedures of Second Language Teaching (or the former EDUB 1620)
- EDUB 3508 (3) Language and Content Instruction of EAL Students (or the former EDUB 1620)
- EDUB 3510 (3) Language Awareness for Teachers (or the former EDUB 3502 with same title)
- EDUB 3426 (3) La pédagogie du français de base aux niveaux intermédiaire et de la jeune enfance

Indigenous Education and Inclusive Education/Diversity courses are in high demand. As such, students in Year 1 are permitted to register for one Indigenous Education course and one Inclusive Education/Diversity course in their first year. Any student in Year 1 who has registered for more than one Indigenous Education course or more than one Inclusive Education/Diversity course will be removed from one (the Scheduling Coordinator will determine which one).

If by August 18 space remains in these courses, Year 1 students will be permitted to register for another. You can check Aurora after August 18 to see if there is space available.

NOTE : If you are enrolled in Early Years, the course EDUB 3018 meets the 3 credit hours of Inclusive Education/Diversity requirement and you do not need to register in an additional one.
