

Raymond and Barbara Bailey *Bursary*

An Endowment Fund of \$10,000 has been established by Raymond and Barbara Bailey to support students in the Faculty of Education at the University of Manitoba.

Raymond Ronald Bailey was born in Brandon in 1922, and after a public school education completed a Bachelor of Science degree at Brandon College in 1944. Bailey pursued further studies at the University of Manitoba, where he earned a Diploma in Education ('46), followed by Bachelor of Education ('57) and Master of Education ('66) degrees.

During his teaching career, Bailey was strongly committed to teacher professionalism through his involvement with the Manitoba Teachers' Society. He was also associated with the promotion of educational adjuncts, home, school and public Libraries, as well as being an early advocate and user of computers in the classroom. Bailey married Joan Pettipher in 1949, and they had four children. Joan passed away after a battle with cancer in 1988, and Bailey has since remarried, to Barbara, a philanthropist and humanitarian. Together they enjoy a life of helping to improve the welfare and happiness of those less fortunate.

Each year a bursary shall be offered to a student who:

- a) is enrolled full-time (min. 9 credit hours in each of the Fall and Winter terms; 18 credit hours in total) in any year of study in the Bachelor of Education Program (currently includes Weekend College and Integrated/Music Education Program)
- b) has achieved a minimum DGPA of 2.5 (first year students must have achieved a 2.5 DGPA in their last year of full-time study (minimum of 9 credit hours each of the Fall and Winter terms))
- c) has demonstrated potential as an educational leader to both guide and motivate others
- d) has demonstrated ingenuity and innovation for implementing new ideas
- e) has demonstrated financial need on the standard University of Manitoba bursary application form

Application Process

- a) complete and submit a University of Manitoba bursary application form by the deadline date to the Financial Aid and Awards Office
- b) complete the supplemental application form and submit to the Faculty of Education, Academic Standing Committee by the deadline date
