



AWARDS - GRADUATE

Berkes Graduate Scholarship in Community-Based Research

Award Value: \$3,000

Eligibility Criteria: The scholarship will be offered to an applicant who:

- (1) is enrolled full-time in the Faculty of Graduate Studies at the University of Manitoba, either in a Master's or a Ph.D. program;
- (2) is pursuing studies in community-based research methods including, but not limited to, community-based resource and environmental management, conservation and planning;
- (3) has achieved a minimum degree grade point average of 3.5 (or equivalent) on the last 60 credit hours of courses (graduate and undergraduate); and,
- (4) does not already hold a UMGF, SSHRC or other major award greater than \$5,000.

Application Details: Applicants will be required to submit the following on or before the deadline to the Awards Secretary, Clayton H. Riddell Faculty of Environment, Earth, and Resources, 440 Wallace Building:

- (1) Completed application form - available online at umanitoba.ca/environment/awards/berkes.html
- (2) A copy of the research proposal (maximum of 2 pages);
- (2) Two letters of reference. One of the letters must be from the graduate advisor, indicating (i) that the applicant does not already hold a major award, as outlined in criterion four above, and (ii) that this scholarship will make a major difference in the applicant's ability to carry out the proposed research.
- (3) A current academic transcript(s) - web transcripts accepted for UManitoba programs only. Transcripts from external institutions need be official transcripts
- (4) A list of all scholarships and awards received since admission to your graduate program (start with the most recent and include name of award(s), period held and monetary value).
