

Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector Information

Important Notes

1. Ensure you request a Criminal Record Check with **Vulnerable Sector**
2. Ensure you Share your Criminal Record Check with the **College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba** and with the **Max Rady College of Medicine**
3. All Physician Assistant Students must submit their Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector **before** the beginning of class.
4. Criminal record checks can take **over a month** to process, please ensure you complete your Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector **as soon as possible**
5. If you receive paper copies of your Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector, please send the **original** copy to the Mater of Physician Assistant Studies with attention to: Jenessa Grabski located at 260 Brodie Centre – 727 McDermot Avenue, Winnipeg Manitoba, R3E 3P5

For Winnipeg Residents:
