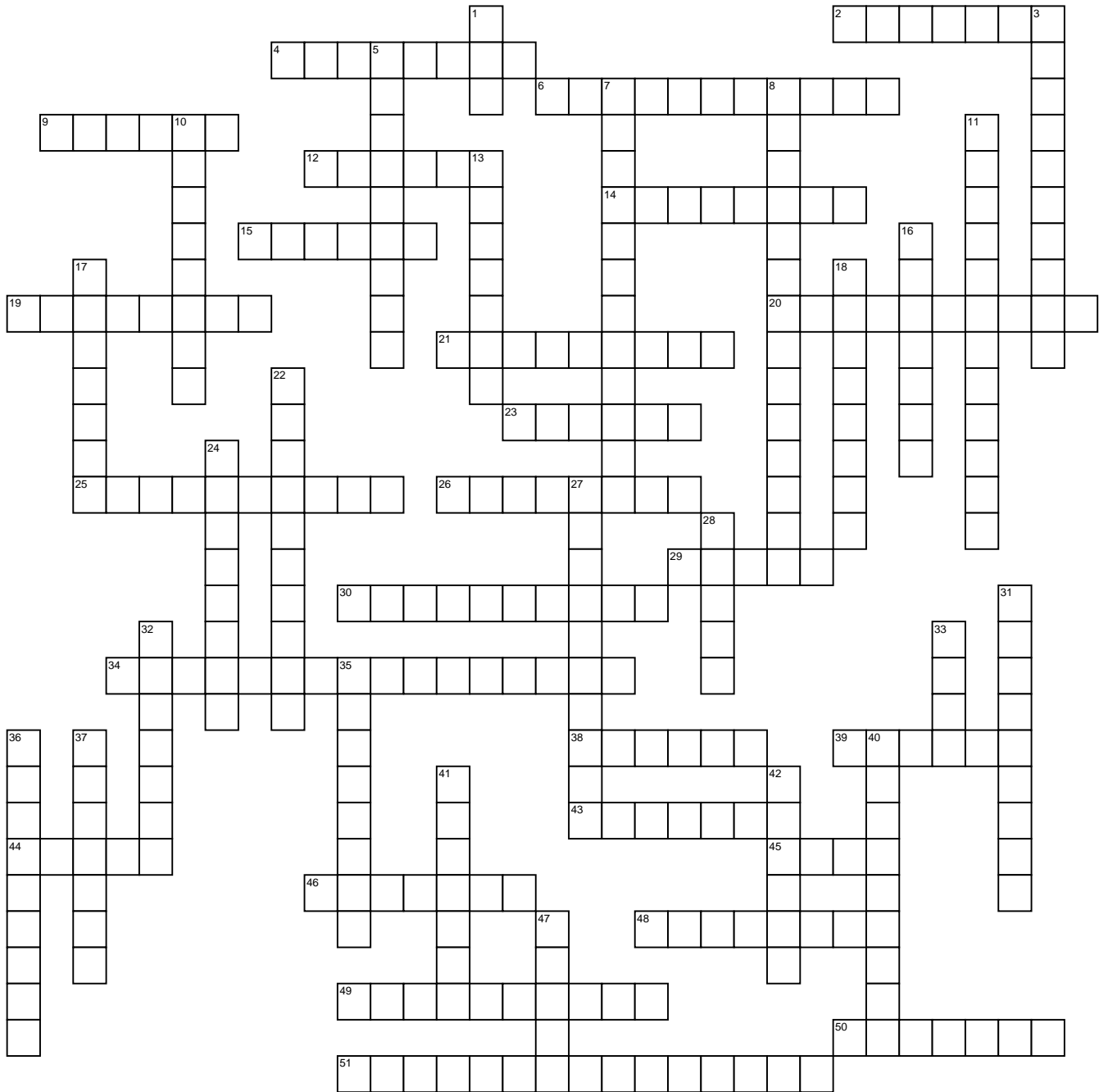

ACROSS

- 2 Tympanic membrane (2 wds)
- 4 Superficial neck muscle
- 6 Motor nerve of the tongue
- 9 Nerve whose branches emerge from the anterior border of parotid
- 12 Nerve sensory to cheek
- 14 Nerve innervating lateral rectus muscle
- 15 Part of ear with pharyngeal connection
- 19 Tonsil guarding entrance to oropharynx
- 20 Tonsil guarding entrance to nasopharynx
- 21 Skull cap
- 23 Hamulus of the _____

- 25 Smallest of the major salivary glands
- 26 Foramen transmitting middle meningeal artery
- 29 Anterior nasal openings
- 30 Nerve innervating levator palpebrae superioris
- 34 Roots of nerve encircling middle meningeal a.
- 38 Cranial fossa lodging cavernous sinus
- 39 Results from denervation of superior tarsal muscle
- 43 Parasympathetic ganglion of the orbit
- 44 Part of the ear lodging vestibulocochlear organ
- 45 Ganglion in infratemporal

- 46 Sinus into which transverse sinuses drain
- 48 Tear gland
- 49 Division of CN V associated with otic ganglion
- 50 "Windpipe"
- 51 Cranial nerve traversing posterior triangle of neck (2 wds)

- 1 Combined hinge and sliding synovial joint (abbr)
- 3 Foramen entered by inferior alveolar neurovascular bundle
- 5 Nerve whose latin name

- means pulley
- 7 Glands maintaining serum calcium levels
- 8 Ganglion associated with CN V2
- 10 Pharyngeal tonsils
- 11 Muscle that protrudes tongue
- 13 Nerve sensory to anterior tongue
- 16 Cartilage of "Adam's Apple"
- 17 Opening between vocal folds
- 18 Tonsils within the fauces
- 22 Extrinsic tongue muscle
- 24 Double vision
- 27 Division of CN V associated with ciliary ganglion
- 28 Nerve enclosed within carotid sheath
- 31 Double-bellied suprahyoid

- muscle
- 32 Foramen at which internal jugular vein originates
- 33 Gingiva
- 35 Double-bellied neck muscle
- 36 Artery from which middle meningeal a. arises
- 37 Branch of CN V1 giving rise to supraorbital and supratrochlear nerves
- 40 Nerve innervating superior oblique muscle
- 41 Artery traveling through cavernous sinus
- 42 Nearsightedness
- 47 Soft palate appendage
