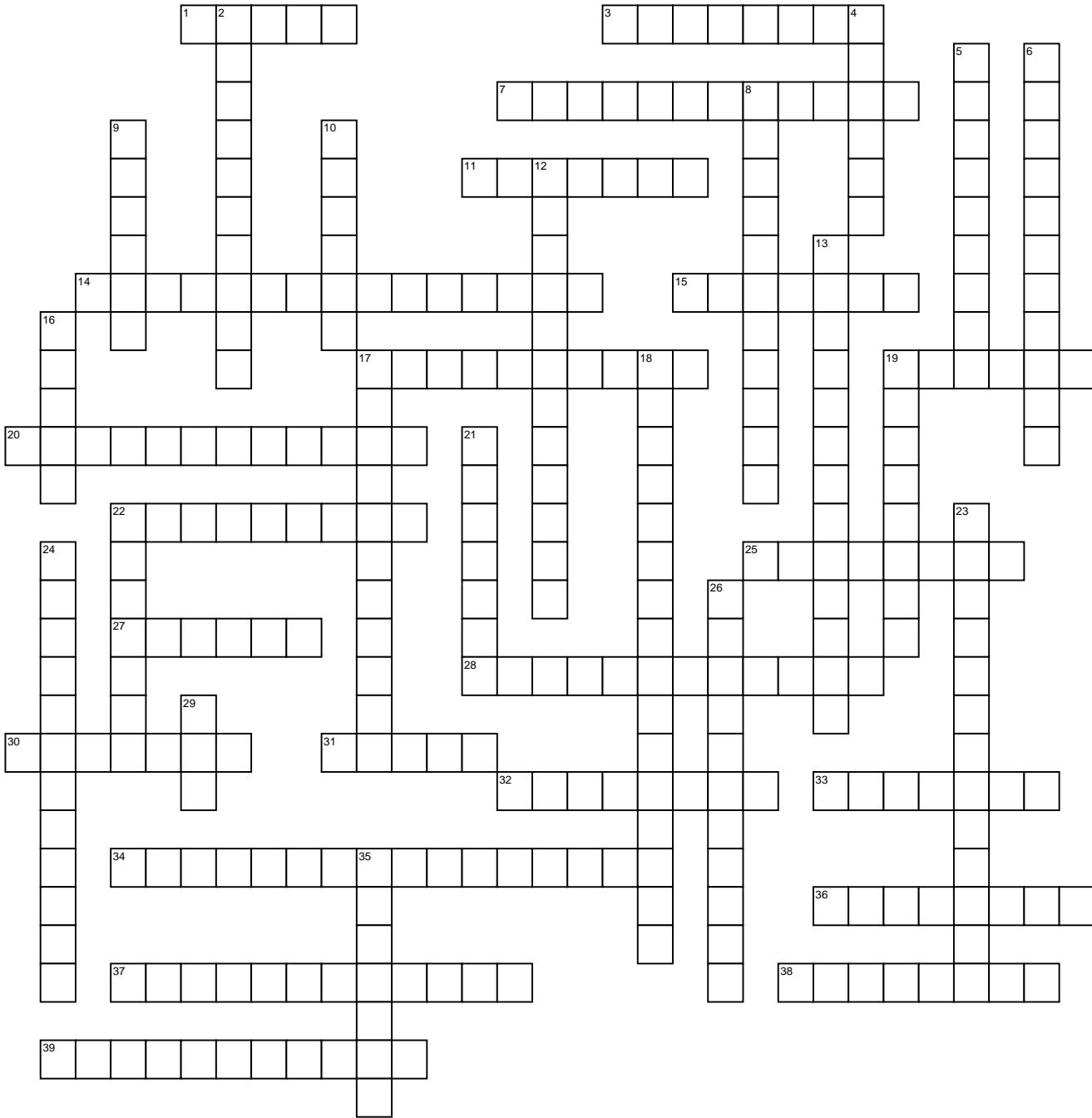


Pelvis and Perineum 1



- for wrinkled skin of scrotum
- 12 Fimbriated end of Fallopian tube
- 13 Pea-sized glands located in the deep perineal pouch
- 16 Most common type of ectopic pregnancy
- 17 Duct arising from the seminal vesicle
- 18 Muscle overlying crura of clitoris
- 19 Erectile organ
- 21 Pelvic organ located inferior to the peritoneum
- 22 Stones that interfere with urine drainage
- 23 Infection of the glands that secrete mucus into the vestibule of vagina
- 24 Muscle that relaxes to permit defecation
- 26 Mesentery of oviduct
- 29 Joined by duct of seminal vesicle
- 35 External female genitalia

ACROSS

- 1 Exercises intended to strengthen the perineal muscles
- 3 Vaginal recesses surrounding cervix
- 7 Nerves conveying pain from abdominopelvic viscera
- 11 Site of ovum fertilization
- 14 Muscle enclosing penile urethra
- 15 Foreskin
- 17 Proximal to the vas deferens and distal to efferent ductules
- 19 Neck of uterus
- 20 Female gland that is homologous of the prostate
- 22 Muscle that overlies sacrospinous ligament
- 25 Urethral sphincter that voluntarily maintains urinary continence
- 27 3-5 caudalmost fused vertebrae
- 28 Pouch between rectum and bladder
- 30 Glands that secrete thick alkaline, fructose-rich fluid, an energy source for sperm
- 31 Membrane covering opening of vagina
- 32 Nerve of the perineum
- 33 Attachment for the sacrotuberous ligament
- 34 Motor to the detrusor muscle
- 36 Male pelvic organ that is

- 2 Surgical incision of perineum
- 4 Plexus giving rise to the sciatic and pudendal nerves
- 5 Occasionally arises abnormally from inferior epigastric artery
- 6 Anomalous location of opening of external urethral orifice
- 8 Partially shed on menstruation
- 9 Rounded superior part of uterus
- 10 Muscle responsible
- 12 Fimbriated end of Fallopian tube
