DESCRIPTION/OVERVIEW OF PROGRAM *(maximum 250 words)*

Extensive experience with knee shoulder reconstruction and upper extremity surgery is available through this fellowship. Very busy Sports Medicine and upper extremity surgeons contribute to the clinical load. Clinical research and outcome studies are also encouraged as part of the program.

Clinical exposure to amateur and professional athletes and coverage of teams at the professional level are included. Participation in rounds and some teaching responsibilities are also part of the program. The fellow should be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba. This fellowship takes place at the Pan Am clinic which is a state of the art free standing facility complete with MRI, five operating rooms, Primary Care, Orthopedics, Plastics and dedicated research space. The Arthroscopic Skills Training Centre has recently been established at the Pan Am Clinic with virtual arthroscopic trainers, musculoskeletal models and access to cadaveric specimens.
