

DEAN RUTH E. BERRY — MANITOBA ASSOCIATION OF HOME ECONOMISTS AWARD

The annual income of the endowment fund established in commemoration of outstanding contributions made by Professional Home Economist, Dr. Ruth Berry, will support an award which will be presented each year to a student who:

- (1) enrolls full-time in the Faculty of Human Ecology in the year in which the award is tenable;
- (2) registers in the next ensuing year of their program;
- (3) has achieved high standing (minimum dgpa of 3.5) among students who have completed at least 54 credit hours and no more than 84 credit hours toward their Bachelor of Human Ecology degree or their Bachelor of Human Ecology (Family Social Sciences) degree; and
- (4) has demonstrated leadership abilities and/or a commitment to community through his or her volunteer activities.

Preference will be given to students who have indicated an interest in Family Economic Health.

The Committee of selection for this award shall be named by the Dean of the Faculty of Human Ecology and shall include a representative from the Manitoba Association of Home Economists.

Candidates must submit an application consisting of a statement (maximum 500 words) describing their volunteer activities and demonstrated leadership abilities. Also submit two letters of reference (maximum 500 words each). The letters of support should address the candidate's leadership abilities and volunteer activities.

Application deadline: April 30.
