

International Students and Internship Applications...

Foreign students have 90 days, after the date of their graduation, to find a job and apply for employment authorization. For foreign students graduating in May, that means that they can accept the internship offer in March, apply for employment authorization right after they graduate, and commence their internship program in September. Foreign students are only authorized to work in a job related to their course of study for a maximum of one year.

Foreign students who wish to apply for employment authorization must provide:

- ✓ Notification of successful completion of all academic programs - a copy of a final transcript and/or letter from the institution showing the course of study;
- ✓ A letter from the employer describing the job, duties, and salary as well as duration of employment.

Students should confirm individual details with a representative from Citizenship and Immigration Canada.
