

LOCKHART AWARD FOR FAMILY SOCIAL SCIENCES

Mr. Joshua Lockhart offers an annual convocation prize at the University of Manitoba, for a graduate of the Bachelor of Human Ecology (Family Social Sciences) program who has demonstrated leadership potential. One prize, with a value of \$500, will be offered to the student who:

- (1) has successfully completed the requirements of the Bachelor of Human Ecology (Family Social Sciences) program;
- (2) has achieved a minimum dgpa of 3.0;;
- (3) has demonstrated the potential to be a strong leader through involvement in the Faculty of Human Ecology and/or volunteer work in the community.

Preference will be given to students who have significant social obligations, e.g., children or care of disabled or elderly members of their family or extended family.

The Committee of selection for this award will be the Student Standing and Awards Committee for the Faculty of Human Ecology.

Candidates must submit an application including a statement (maximum one page) in which they (a) describe their involvement in the Faculty and volunteer activities and (b) outline specific experiences that speak to their leadership abilities.

Application deadline: April 30.
