

## **2011 Stuart Clark Investment Competition Agenda/Guide for Championship Round Judges**

Thank you for being a judge in the Championship Round of the 2011 Stuart Clark Investment Competition. To help understand your role and responsibilities, please read the following instructions. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact us.

You will be notified by email of the first three teams making the Championship Round at the conclusion of the Opening Round on April 1, 2011. This email should arrive as a Deal Alert from Angelsoft at approximately 1:30 pm. You will receive a second Deal Alert notice at approximately 6:00 pm containing the name of the Wild Card entry admitted to the finals. Once you receive the Deal Alerts, please start reading the plans. If you prefer, please feel free to print the plans out for review. For those judges without access to email or who prefer a hard copy, these will be available at the end of the Advisors and Judges dinner being held at Rob Warren's house. As a Championship Round judge, we invite you to attend this event.

### **Time to arrive:**

- Please arrive at Fort Garry Hotel before 1:00pm on Saturday, April 2, 2011. If you would like, we have a luncheon scheduled from 12:00 to 1:00 pm that day for the competitors that we would be happy for you to attend. This will be held in the Selkirk Room. Please collect your name tag and judging packet from a representative of the Stu Clark Centre staff in the Selkirk Room. At the conclusion of lunch, please proceed to the Club Room located in the lower level of the hotel.
- If you arrive after 1:00 pm, please proceed directly to The Club Room where a Stu Clark Centre representative will provide you with a name tag and judging package.
- At 1:15pm, Rob Warren will come to the Club Room and brief the judging panel as well as answer any last minute questions. Two score sheets (presentation and viability) will be provided for each team.

### **What to do during and after each session (15min presentation + 20min Q&A):**

- Please fill out the two score sheets for each team. These will not be provided to the teams but should be used during deliberations.

### **What to do after the Championship Round:**

We have a boardroom available for the judges to meet in while you deliberate. Refreshments will be provided at this time. The panel only needs to identify a first and second place team. These decisions should be based on the consensus of the judging panel and not simply on the scores recorded on the judging sheets. The remaining two teams will be recognized as finalists. At the conclusion of the deliberations, a Stu Clark Centre representative will collect the forms and other materials. ***We appreciate your time and expertise! Have fun and enjoy!***
