DIRECT ENTRY CATEGORY

In order for a student to be eligible to apply directly to the Asper School of Business for September 2011, high school applicants must meet the criteria listed below:

1. Manitoba high school graduation (or equivalent), with 5 full credits at the Grade 12 level, in courses designated S, G or U.

2. A minimum 85% average over three courses:

■ Pre-Calculus 40S or Applied Mathematics 40S (Pre-Calculus recommended)

■ English 40S

■ One other 40S or U course

3. A minimum 60% in each of the three courses noted in point 2 above.

Note: *The direct entry category will replace the guaranteed admission category. The guaranteed admission category will no longer be offered.*

TRACK 1: FROM U1 OR ANOTHER UNIVERSITY

You must have all of the qualifying requirements listed below (or the equivalent) with the minimum grade requirements. The number in brackets indicates credit hours.

Prior to September 2011

■ Psychology PSYC 1200 or Sociology SOC 1200 (6)

■ Economics ECON 1200 (6)

■ Mathematics MATH 1520 or MATH 1500 (3)

■ Mathematics MATH 1310 or MATH 1300 (3)

■ A 3 or 6 credit hour course that satisfies the Written English (“W”) requirement (3-6)

■ 0-3 credit hours of electives (depending on the chosen “W” course) (0-3)

■ Total of 24 credit hours with a minimum grade of C in each course

■ You must complete a minimum of 24 credit hours by April 30

Effective September 2011

These Track 1 changes are proceeding, pending approval.

■ 6 credit hours from: Anthropology ANTH, History HIST, Mathematics MATH, Philosophy PHIL, Political Studies POLS, Psychology PSYC or Sociology SOC (6)

Note: *Courses chosen for this requirement must be independent from courses that satisfy other program requirements*

■ Economics ECON 1200 (6) or (ECON 1010 (3) and ECON 1020 (3))

■ Statistics STAT 1000 (3)

■ Mathematics MATH 1520 or MATH 1500 (3)

■ A 3 or 6 credit hour course, from a specific discipline, that satisfies the Written English (“W”) requirement (ARTS 1110 (3) is excluded from this requirement) (3-6)

■ 0-3 credit hours of electives (depending on the chosen “W” course) (0-3)

■ Total of 24 credit hours with a minimum grade of C in each course

■ You must complete a minimum of 24 credit hours by April 30

Note: *Students applying for the academic year beginning in September 2011 are eligible for admission under either the previous admission requirements (see “Prior to September 2011”) or the new admission requirements (see “Effective September 2011”). All newly admitted students will follow the School’s new curriculum.*

TRACK 2

If you are missing one or more of the Track 1 course requirements, you can apply for admission via Track 2, providing that you have (a) completed a minimum of 24 credit hours by April 30; (b) achieved a minimum admission GPA of 3.10; and (c) achieved a minimum grade of C on each course comprising the 24 credit hours. Track 2 spots are limited in number.

Note: *Although 24 credit hours is the minimum requirement for admission via Track 1 and Track 2, a full-year course load would require 30 credit hours. Therefore, students taking only 24 credit hours for admission will need to pick up an extra 6 credit hours of course work once admitted into the Asper School of Business.*

OTHER ADMISSION METHODS
