## **SIZE OF THE AWARD: \$350**

**ELIGIBILITY:** The award will be offered to an Asper School of Business student who:

1. has completed all requirements for the Bachelor of Commerce (Honours) degree with a major in Accounting;
2. has been admitted to the CASB program in pursuit of a Chartered Accountant designation following graduation;
3. has been nominated by students and/or faculty as the “most well-rounded” student among those graduating in a given year (see next page for nomination form).

The Asper School of Business is asking for nominations from faculty and students, naming a student who best exemplifies the “most well-rounded” student, taking into account academics as well as extra-curricular involvement, among the Accounting graduating class (including October 2011, February 2012, and May 2012 graduates).

Nominators will be asked to outline the extra-curricular and volunteer contributions made by the nominee, such as involvement, personal initiative, and accomplishments in areas of organizational responsibility and leadership through active involvement in community, academic, or youth groups and activities (some examples include AIESEC [Association Internationale des Etudiantes de Sciences, Economiques, et Commerce], Junior Achievement, and Intramural or Intercollegiate sports).
