

# **THE NORTH WEST COMPANY ABORIGINAL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP IN BUSINESS**

The North West Company has established a fund at the University of Manitoba to provide an annual scholarship to Aboriginal students in the Asper School of Business.

**AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP: \$1,125**

## **ELIGIBILITY**

A \$1,125 scholarship shall be offered to a student who:

1. is Aboriginal (Status, non-Status, Metis, Inuit);
2. in Fall/Winter 2010-2011, was registered in at least 18 credit hours\*\* as a student in the Asper School of Business;
3. after Fall/Winter 2010-2011, had completed between 30 and 111 credit hours of the 126 credit hours required for the Bachelor of Commerce (Honours) degree;
4. in Fall/Winter 2011-2012, is registered in at least 18 credit hours\*\* as a student in the Asper School of Business (or if the student is graduating in February 2012, is registered in at least 9 credit hours in Fall 2011);
5. has a minimum degree GPA of 3.00.

\*\* To be eligible for this scholarship, students completing an Asper Co-op Work Term during this time period must have completed at least 9 credit hours (60% course load) during each of their academic terms.

## **APPLICATION PACKAGE**

Each applicant must submit:

1. the application form;
2. a resume;
3. a letter (maximum 500 words) describing how the applicant has demonstrated responsibility and leadership through active involvement in community, academic, sports, or youth organizations.

The selection committee shall be named by the Dean of the Asper School of Business and shall include a representative of the North West Company.
