

VISION QUEST – STEVE PRINCE MEMORIAL BURSARY

Vision Quest Conferences Inc. (www.vqconference.com) has established a fund at the University of Manitoba to provide a bursary to assist Aboriginal students in the Asper School of Business. The bursary is named in memory of a Founding Director of Vision Quest Conferences Inc., Mr. Steve Prince.

AMOUNT OF BURSARY: \$1,000

A \$1,000 bursary will be offered to a student who:

1. is Aboriginal (Status, non-Status, Metis, Inuit);
2. in Fall/Winter 2010-2011, completed at least 18 credit hours at the University of Manitoba;
3. in Fall/Winter 2011-2012, is registered in at least 18 credit hours as a student in the Asper School of Business;
4. has completed at least 24 credit hours of university course work;
5. has a minimum degree GPA of 2.50;
6. has demonstrated involvement in the Aboriginal community;
7. has demonstrated financial need on the online University of Manitoba general bursary application form. Applicants must have completed this on-line form by October 3, 2011.

The bursary recipient will be extended an invitation to attend the Vision Quest Conference, usually held in the month of May, following the academic session in which the bursary is tenable. Vision Quest Conference requests that the recipient act as a representative of the Aboriginal community by having their name publicized and announced at the Vision Quest Conference.

Applicants are required to submit: a) the application form; b) a one-page letter (maximum 250 words) stating how you have demonstrated involvement in the Aboriginal community.
