Since 2002, students in the University of Manitoba Faculties of **Medicine**, and now **Dentistry and Nursing** have been collecting donated textbooks to send via Canadian Forces to universities in Kabul, Kandahar and Herat, working together under the *Books with Wings* (<http://bookswithwings.ca>) project. Students at universities across Canada, recently University of Toronto, Memorial University of Newfoundland, and the University of Western Ontario, have continued to help out. Over 3400 books have been shipped so far, valued at an average of \$150 each (over \$500,000 worth). Many more books are needed. In 2006/2007 we are expanding to books in **Engineering** and **Mathematics**.

Books should be less than 10 years old or of lasting value. Older books will be sold to buy new ones.
